AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING THE PROHIBITION AGAINST DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES DURING THE 2022 FRENCHTOWN SUMMER UNITY PICNIC.

Whereas, Section 600.100 of the Code of Ordinances prohibits the drinking of alcoholic beverages upon the public streets, avenues, alleys or other public places in the City; and

Whereas, Section 600.100(A)(3) allows the City to designate a public place where the prohibition shall not apply; and

Whereas, the City desires to suspend the prohibition against drinking alcoholic beverages during the Frenchtown Summer Unity Picnic to be held on Saturday, June 18, 2022; on Randolph Street, between N. Second Street and N. Third Street, during the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of St. Charles, Missouri, as Follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 600.100(A)(3) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Saint Charles, Missouri, Section 600.100 shall be of no force and effect as to the drinking of alcoholic beverages from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 18, 2022, on Randolph Street, between N. Second Street and N. Third Street.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
