SUBJECT: IA Registration Period Extension Request for
FEMA-4665-DR-MO

The State of Missouri has requested a thirty (30) day extension to the Individual Assistance registration period for FEMA-4665-DR-MO. The current deadline for registration is October 7, 2022.

Missouri's request is based on the Individual Assistance Program registration extension analysis provided to FEMA-4665-DR-MO senior leadership by the Individual Assistance Branch Director.

The analysis reflects:

- The average number of daily registrations continue to be around 300.
- Between day 39 and 45 of the registration period, 2,070 valid registrations or (10%) were received of the 21,260 total registrations.
- Between day 39 and 45 of the registration period, the eligibility rate for FEMA-4665-DR-MO was almost 20% higher compared to disasters of similar size and type and has remained higher than historical average throughout the event at 65% or higher.
- The average IHP award for FEMA-4665-DR-MO for the entire registration period is \$2,503. The average IHP award from day 39 to 45 continues to exceed \$2,000 at \$2,121.
- At least one of the designated areas exceeds the national average in a factor contributing to social vulnerability.

Based on the justification provided by the State of Missouri in the attached letter and the conditions described above. I am authorizing the thirty (30) day extension to the registration period as requested for FEMA-4665-DR-MO. The registration period will now end on November 7, 2022.
