- Vendors must be in good financial standing with the City of Saint Charles.

Waivers of Liability Requirements

- Vendors retain sole responsibility for their merchandise throughout the event. Vendors shall release, indemnify, defend and hold harmless The City of Saint Charles, its elected and appointed officials, successors, assigns, legal representatives, officers, employees, and agents (collectively, “indemnities”) for, from and against any and all claims, liabilities, cost damages, losses, causes of action, suits, demands, judgments and expenses (including, without limitation, court costs, attorneys’ fees and costs of investigation or otherwise (collectively “liabilities”) of any nature, kind or description of any person or entity directly or indirectly arising out of, resulting from or related to (in whole or in part) merchandise loss or property damage of any kind whatsoever resulting from or connected to the operation of Vendor’s area.
